

Little Yeti Amigurumi

You Will Need:

- Crochet hook (2-3 sizes smaller than suggested on yarn label for nice, tight stitches.)
- Yarn (2 colors)
- Safety eyes, buttons, beads, or embroidery floss to make eyes
- Stitch markers or scrap piece of yarn
- Yarn and/or embroidery needle
- Poly-fil or other type of stuffing



Abbreviations

- Ch – Chain Stitch
- Sc – Single Crochet
- St/Sts – Stitch/Stitches
- Slst – Slip Stitch
- Inc (Increase) – 2 Sc into 1 St
- Dec (Decrease) – 1 Sc across 2 Sts
- ** – Marks a group of stitches to be repeated until the round is completed

Gauge

No gauge. Stitches should be nice and tight to avoid gaps in your work

Finished Size depends on thickness of yarn and hook size used

Arms (make 2 using main color)

1. Start 8 sc in a magic ring (or ch 2 and place 8 sc in second chain from hook.) (8)
 9. Flatten and sc across top (3) (Do not stuff)
- Fasten off, leaving long tail for sewing pieces together.

Legs (make 2 using main color)

1. Start 6 sc in a magic ring (or ch 2 and place 6 sc in second chain from hook.) (6)
 2. Inc in all six stitches (12)
 - 3-5. SC around (12)
- Fasten off.

Crochet second leg but do not fasten off.

Chain 3 and join to first leg with a slip stitch. Continue crocheting the body in the round.

Body (using main color)

6. Sc 12 around the first leg, sc in each of the ch3, sc 12 around the second leg, 3 sc in each of the ch3 (opposite side). (30)
- 7-12. Sc around. (30)

The arms will be attached as you crochet R13 by stitching the arm and the body together.
(Alternate option: sc around (30) and sew arms to body later. *)

13. Sc 5, attach arm with next 3 sc, sc 12, attach other arm with next 3 sc, sc 7. (30)

14-16. Sc around. (30)

17. *Sc 3, dec* around. (24)

18. *Sc, dec, sc* around. (18)

Stuff firmly

19. *Sc, dec* around. (12)

20. Dec around. (6)

Fasten off. Use tail to close gap at top.

Face (use alternate color)

1. Start 8 sc in a magic ring (or ch 2 and place 8 sc in second chain from hook.) (8)

2. Inc 2, sc 2, inc 2, sc 2. (12)

3. Sc 2, inc 3, sc 3, inc 3, sc. (18)

4. Sc 2, inc, sc, inc, sc 6, inc, sc, inc, sc 3. (22)

Fasten off, leaving long tail for sewing pieces together.

Embroider or insert safety eyes between rows 2 and 3, with 4 stitches between the eyes.

Sew face onto body.

(*If arms still need to be attached, sew to body at round 13.)

Tie short piece of yarn to the top of the yeti's head. Untwist so that it looks like hair and trim to desired length.

Weave yarn ends into body.
