S'more Library Card Holder / Stuffed Toy

You Will Need:

- Crochet hook (2-3 sizes smaller than suggested on yarn label for nice, tight stitches.)
- Yarn light worsted weight light brown, white, and dark brown
- Buttons, beads, or embroidery floss to make eyes (safety eyes do **not** work well for card holder but can be used for fidget toy.)
- Stitch markers or scrap piece of yarn
- Yarn and/or embroidery needle
- Poly-fil or other type of stuffing for toy
- Small button for card holder.



- Ch Chain Stitch
- Sc Single Crochet
- St/Sts Stitch/Stitches
- Slst Slip Stitch
- Inc (Increase) 2 Sc into 1 St
- Dec (Decrease) 1 Sc across 2 Sts
- ** Marks a group of stitches to be repeated until the round is completed

Finished Size

Card holder will be 2" x 3.5". Stuffed toy will depend on thickness of yarn and hook size used

Horizontal Card Holder

Start with light brown Ch 15

R1: inc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 12 chs, 4 sc in last ch, then working down other side of ch, sc in next 12 ch, inc in last ch. (32)

R2: sc around. (32)

Change yarn to white



R3 – R8: sc around. (32)

Change yarn to dark brown.

For this row, alternating steps are highlighted to help keep track of where you are. R9: **sc 4**, (ch 4, slst into 2nd ch from hook, slst in next 2 chs), **sc4**, (ch , slst into 2nd ch from hook, slst in next ch), **sc5**, (ch 5, slst into 2nd ch from hook, slst in next 3 chs), **sc4**, (ch 3, slst into 2nd ch from hook, slst in next 2 chs), **sc5**, (ch 5, slst into 2nd ch from hook, slst in next 3 chs), **sc4**, (ch 3, slst in next 2 chs), **sc5**, (ch 5, slst into 2nd ch from hook, slst in next 3 chs), **sc4**, (ch 3, slst into 2nd ch from hook, slst in next 2 chs), **sc5**, (ch 5, slst into 2nd ch from hook, slst in next 3 chs), **sc4**, (ch 3, slst into 2nd ch from hook, slst in next 3 chs), **sc4**, (ch 3, slst into 2nd ch from hook, slst in next 3 chs), **sc4**, (ch 3, slst into 2nd ch from hook, slst in next ch), **sc3**. (32sc)

R10: sc around, making sure "chocolate drips" are in front. (32)

Change yarn to light brown R11: sc around. (32)

Add ring for keychain between stitches 16 and 17.

R12: sc 23, make a larger loop to go around button on other side, sc in next st, sc 8. (32)

Fasten off.

*Turn inside out to weave in and trim yarn ends. Turn right side out again.

*Sew button near top on the back side, directly opposite front side loop.

*Embroider or sew on safety eyes between rows 7 and 8, with 5 stitches between the eyes.

*Embroider a smile.
